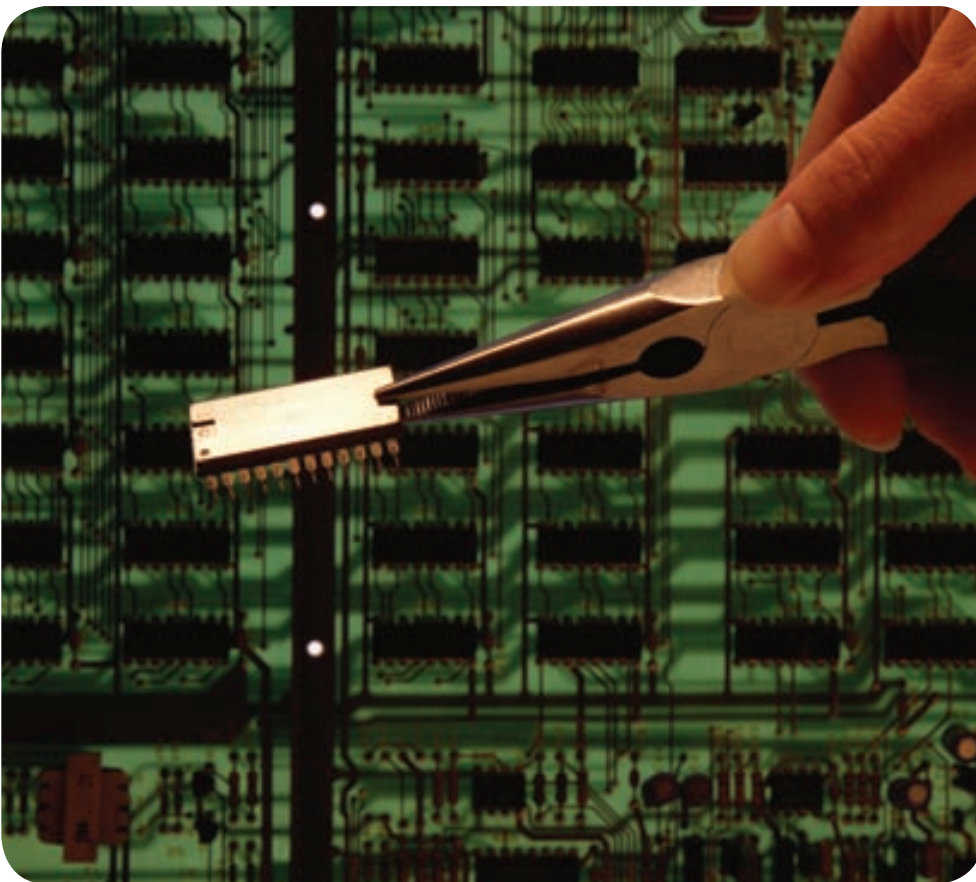

The Program
