Generous Donors Pave The Way

In 1995, former University of Colorado Regent Sandy Kraemer, his family, and several anonymous friends donated a 640-acre parcel of land valued at \$2.2 million to the university. In response, the regents approved naming the library for the Kraemers. Throughout our history, donors have made the UCCS campus the fastest-growing in the CU system, with several programs attaining national stature.
