

Under Dr. Wilson's leadership, students and faculty affiliated with the Center for Global Health are:

- **Training future Rwandan doctors:**

Dr. Wilson is one of several University of Colorado School of Medicine faculty who have visited the only medical school in Rwanda—a country of 10 million with fewer than a dozen specialists in fields such as anesthesiology and ophthalmology—to help educate physicians there.

- **Improving prospects for Guatemalan girls:**

School of Medicine Global Health Track student Casey Weimer developed and implemented a reproductive health and self-esteem education program in 2009 that has helped these young women better help themselves.

- **Developing campaigns to promote community health:**

Recent School of Medicine graduate Doug Melzer conceived a multimedia marketing program to promote hand-washing in an isolated Peruvian village, and inspired local youth activists to sustain and expand the program.

- **Bringing underreported topics to light:**

Center for Global Health symposiums and lectures have addressed topics such as HIV management in resource-limited countries, the impact of war on health, and community health worker training.
