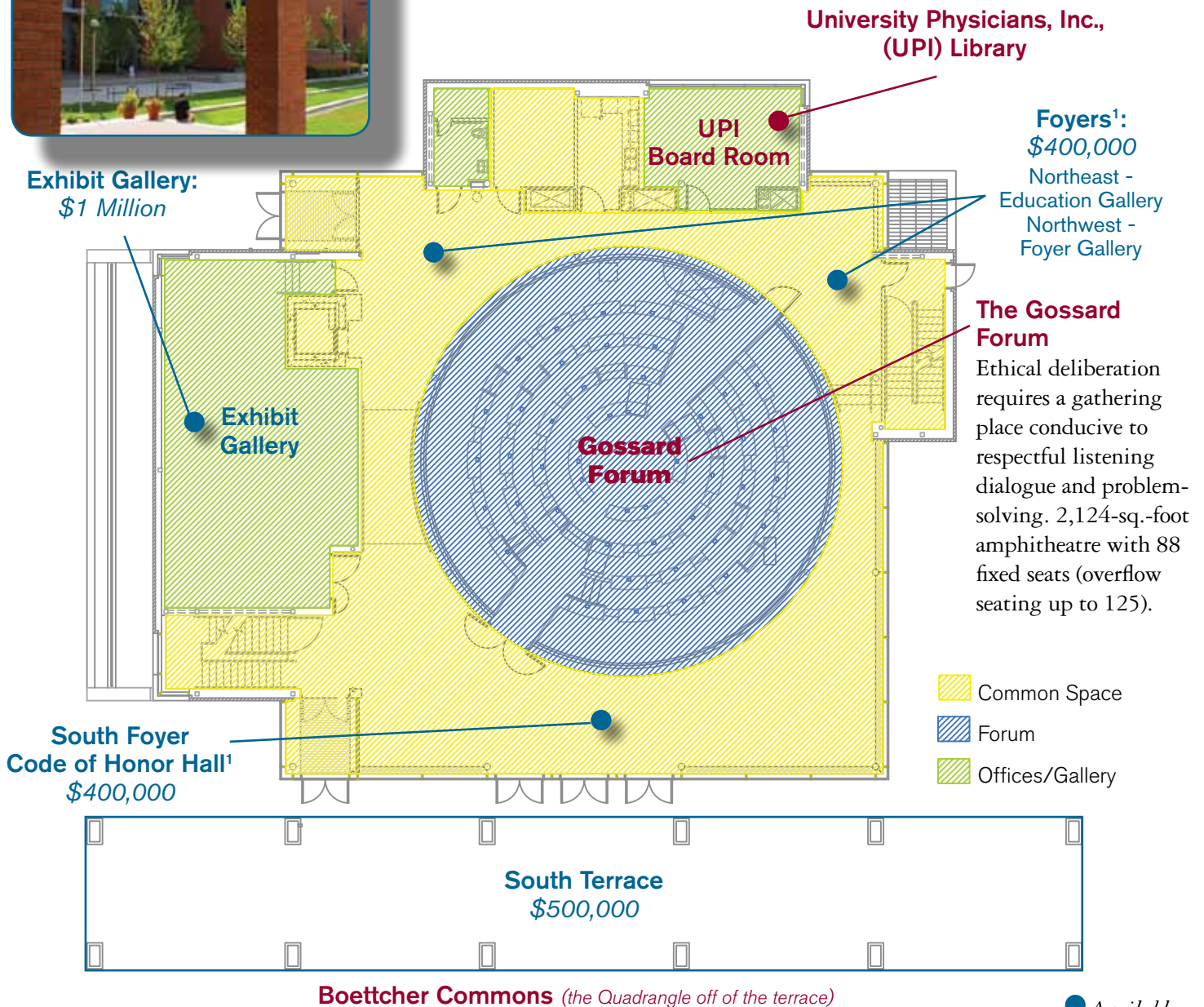
FULGINITI PAVILION FOR ETHICS AND HUMANITIES

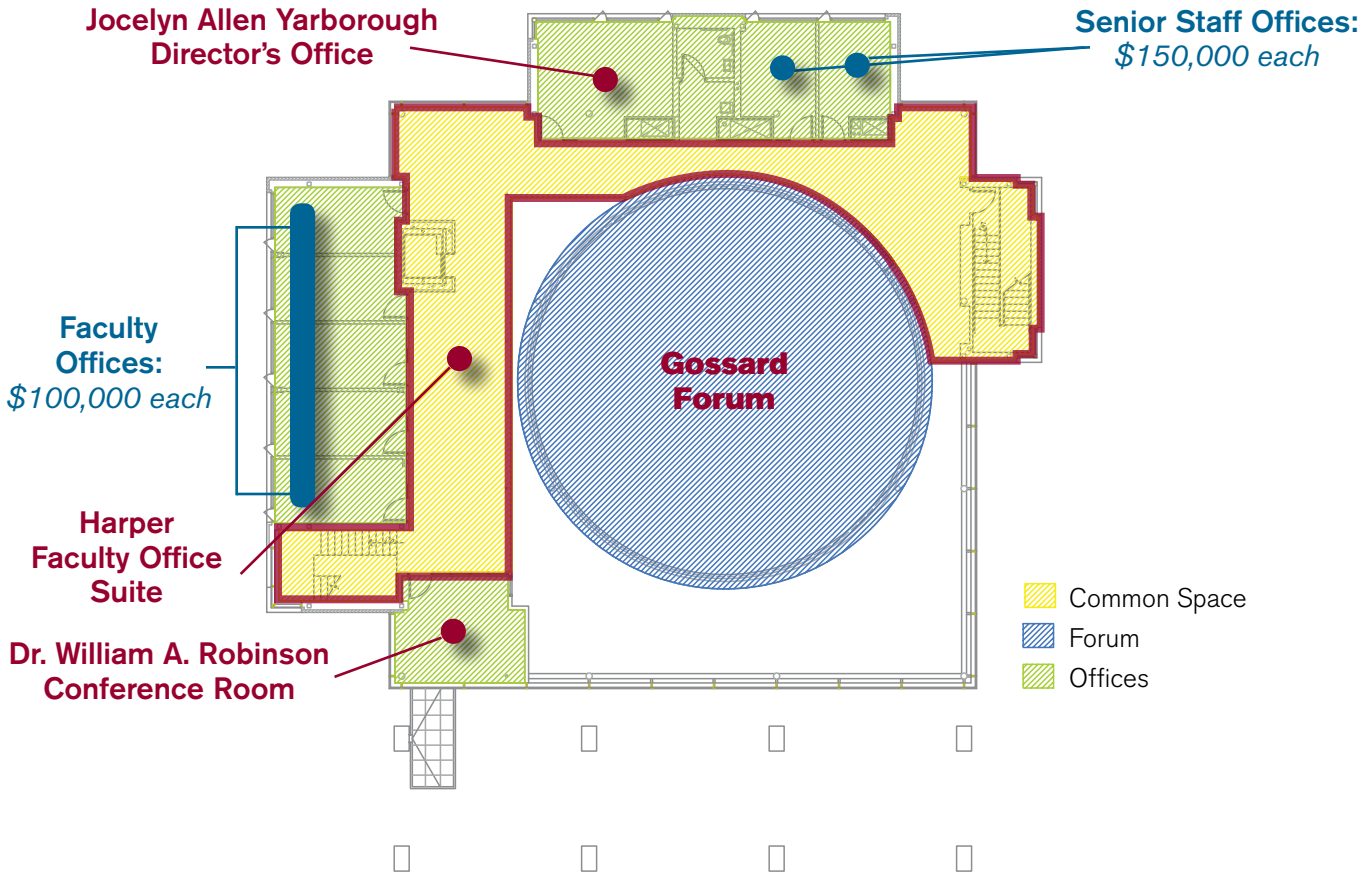
The pavilion will include an atrium, a forum, gallery spaces, and office and seminar spaces.



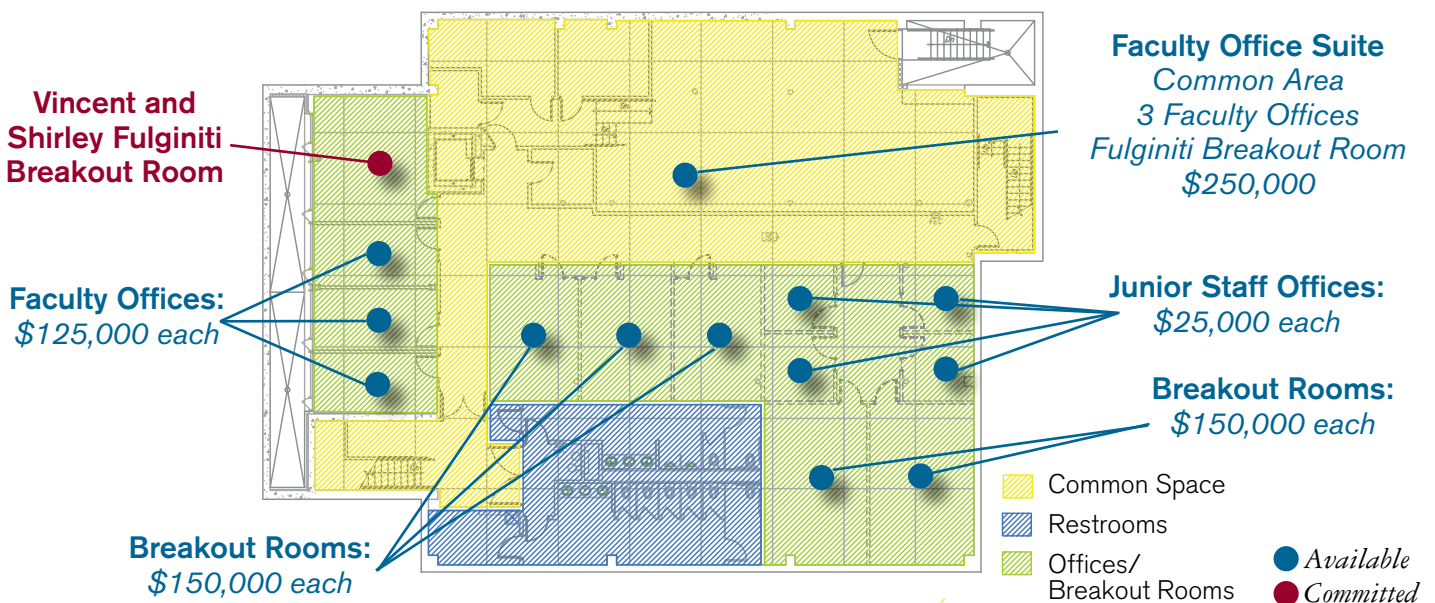
